

## **Video Options with CBTS Hosted VoIP Service**

### **Video Meeting and Bridging Services**

#### **Point to Point**

As a part of the Basic and Enhanced Profiles, point to point video using video phones and devices is built in to the cost of these profiles. Simply call a device on our system from your video device and you can talk face to face.

#### **Point to Multi-point**

Video bridges for meetings on our system are available as a part of the Enhanced profile. Devices on our system with the Basic profile can participate, the Enhanced Profile is required to obtain a video bridge account. Once you obtain an account, you can meet by dialing 1-614-763-6201. You can test this functionality by using the demo bridge that is wide open and has no security, and is meant only to test. It is bridge 21000, and press # and you will be connected to anyone that is on that bridge.

The Video Room Profile for room based systems also includes one of these bridge accounts dedicated for use by this device. Video Room Profiles start at \$29/mo and will go down as pricing tiers are reached. Your device will be registered to the CBTS video bridge service as a part of this profile. This information can also be added to Outlook so that when the conference room is reserved, participant are given information about the bridge account for that room to facilitate meetings.

B2B (Business to Business) service is also available as a part of our contract around this service. Pricing has two models based on whether you want to pay an upfront setup fee and a lower rate, or skip the upfront fee and pay a higher monthly rate. This allows SIP compatible devices to connect from outside of our network by dialing a SIP URI address. Pricing is per concurrent call path.

#### **Video Endpoints**

We continue to add additional video conference end points and systems to the hardware catalog for ease of ordering. We recommend Polycom Group 300 and 500 series devices be considered since they can directly integrate in to Skype for Business.
